## THE HOBBIT EXTENSIVE PROJECTS

### 1. WILDERNESS MAP

10 Complete the map outline coloring and labelling all the major adventure locations. Trace the path of the group using a red crayon.

### 2. RIDDLE CONTESTS

10 Find three Riddles which Bilbo used in his Riddle Contests and copy them. Make five new riddles that Bilbo could have used. Challenge a partner and have your own riddle contest.

### 3. RUNES AND MOON LETTERS

15 Use the key page to translate the message found on the map found on the inside cover. Make two messages in ruin letters each which has eight or more words.

### 4. HOBBIT GLOSSARY

10 Create your own glossary of 25 unique and important words from this story. Organize in alphabetical order and include the meaning of each.

### 5. BOOK REVIEW

10 Complete a Book Review sheet about this novel identifying the major parts of the story.

### 6. VIDEO-NOVEL COMPARISON

10 View the video version of this story and complete a comparison by identifying 10 similarities and 10 differences between the two. Conclude by stating your preference with at least three reasons for support.

### 7. HOBBIT TRIVIA

10 With a partner create 30 trivia questions with four choice answers from this novel. Challenge another pair to a game by keeping score of correct answers.

### 8. CARTOON STRIP

15 Create a cartoon strip of at least 6 pictures which would illustrate and retell a major scene from this story.

### 9. SHOEBOX SETTING

10 Using a shoebox from home, create a setting from this story to display to your classmates. Be prepared to give a short presentation of the setting.

### 10. MOBILE

15 Construct drawings of 6 characters from the story- cut out and create a mobile using cardboard, a hanger and string.

11. CROSSWORD PUZZLE

Choose 25 words from the story and create a crossword puzzle with clues for Down and Across.

12. TV COMMERCIAL

Make a TV commercial advertising this story as a coming attraction to a local movie theatre.

13. BOOK JACKET

Design a new book jacket with a front and back. Include a new illustration, the title, author, about the author, and back introduction to the novel.

14. PLOT DIAGRAM

Make a list of the main events of the plot and organize onto a plot diagram showing the correct location for each.

15. DIARY

Write diary entries for one week that Bilbo may have kept during the most exciting part of this story.

16. CHARACTER SKETCH POSTERS

Choose any two of the following characters and write a character sketch paragraph for each from evidence from the story. Draw a color poster of your character with appropriate background scenery.

17. CHANGES IN BILBO

Bilbo has changed significantly throughout this story. Demonstrate how Bilbo's personality changes from the opening chapter to the closing chapter with examples from the story.

18. CHAPTER 12 CONTINUATION

Write a 250 word short story continuation from Chapter 12 where Smaug would remain in the cave and is destroyed by Bilbo and Company. Remember Bilbo's magic ring and the return of the other characters to aid the group. Rough Copy and two WP edited copies.

19. ELF POEM

Imagine you are an elf and wish to share the legend of this adventure forever in poetic form. Write a POEM in ballad form which briefly shares this adventure with your reader. Ballad form has four verse stanzas with a rhyme pattern.

20. PLAY

Choose a scene from the Hobbit and act it out in front of the class. You may work in groups of 4-6. You must include a script which indicates the lines of the actors and narrator with stage directions. May include costumes, props and background.
