### ADDING THE SUFFIX *ed* to verbs



The suffix *ed* is added to words to form new words. The suffix changes a verb from present tense to past tense.

**Example:** clean + *ed* = cleaned

When a short vowel word ends with only one consonant, we usually double the consonant before adding *ed*. **Example:** hop + *ed* = hopped
