### ADDING THE SUFFIX *ance* TO VERBS

The suffix *ance* is added to words form new words. The suffix *ance* changes a verb to a noun.

**RULE:** When the base word ends in a “silent e” and the suffix begins with a vowel, the “e” is dropped before adding the suffix.

**Example:**    **guide + ance = guidance**
